

Reporting Misconduct

You see, are told or hear about something concerning - this could be an incident, allegation, belief or suspicion of misconduct



Finding and recommendation of investigation. (substantiated or not substantiated)



Investigation

Includes informing alleged perpetrator, who has the right to respond. Respect confidentiality and privacy.

Report to donor and consider reporting to legal authorities (consult with victims)



Consider actions to prevent further harm. Refer victim/survivors to support services
